Cruise Options:

- [Highway 40 \(Highwood Pass\)](#): The highest paved highway in Canada, offering dramatic mountain vistas, wildlife spotting, and alpine scenery (closes seasonally).
- [Sheep River Provincial Park \(Highway 546\)](#): West of Diamond Valley, this route features stunning river views, rocky cliffs, and frequent wildlife, ending at the Sheep River Falls.
- [Highway 22 & 541 \(Cowboy Trail to Kananaskis\)](#): Driving south from Calgary, taking Hwy 22 to Longview and merging onto Hwy 541 provides a dramatic transition from rolling foothills to towering mountains. Hwy 2a to High River, past rodeo grounds turn Rt (Longview Tr 7 St, immediate turn rt (Coal Tr) follow to Longview, Rt on Hwy 22, 3 blocks later turn left onto 541
- [Highway 66 to Elbow Falls](#): West of Bragg Creek, this road winds along the Elbow River, offering beautiful, quick access to the mountains and scenic picnic spots.
- [Highway 1A \(Cochrane to Exshaw\)](#): A quieter, more scenic alternative to the Trans-Canada, running parallel to the mountains through Morley.
